There is a 15% premium for burial plots in the most popular parts of the wood.

Payment of a deposit of £500 allows the donor to select the site, which can be planted with wild flowers.

* The service charge (£480) includes clearing the plot, digging the grave and preparing a suitable area around it for mourners, attending the burial, re-filling the grave and restoring the area with woodland plants such as ferns, and re-planting with native trees. Mourners are welcome to join in with any part of the site restoration process.

** The suggested donation is a contribution to the charity to support long-term maintenance of the site.

We are happy to assist families in choosing and engraving marker stones which can be placed on the grave. The price for an engraved slate marker is usually £100-140, depending on the complexity of the design and number of words.

Indigenous species of trees suitable for planting on burial sites:

Small trees: hawthorn, cherry, holly, elder, crabapple, hazel, guelder rose

Medium trees: rowan, alder, willow, birch

Large trees: oak, beech, sycamore, chestnut, ash, poplar, Scots pine, lime, yew
